Important Drop Off and Pick Up Details

Loading or Unloading—Use the vehicle pick up line at the yellow curb in the morning, during the day, and from 3:20—3:40. Never leave your car unattended at the curb — this is a fire code violation.

Loading or Unloading—Children must load on the passenger side, not on the driver side.

Loading in a hurry — Park your vehicle in the lot and come across the driveway to pick up your children. To ensure safety, we do not allow students to cross alone. Please use the crosswalk to get them.

Talking with someone inside the building or waiting for a student to go in the building— Please park in the parking lot.

Picking up late due to an emergency— Please call the school office if possible. After 3:45 p.m. a late charge will be added to your account. The school handbook states these charge amounts.
