TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE FOR 2011-2012

REGISTRATION: (per year – per family – non-refundable)

Kindergarten – Eighth Grades \$100.00

COMPREHENSIVE FEE: (per year – per student)

Half Day Kindergarten \$225.00

Kindergarten – Second Grades \$225.00

Third – Eighth Grades \$270.00

TUITION: (per year – per student)

Half Day K4 \$1,010.00

Full Day K4 \$1,515.00

Half Day K5 \$1,515.00

Full Day K5 \$2,020.00

First Grade \$2,750.00

No additional tuition discounts apply to K4/K5 and First Grade (CBC membership, early pay, multiple child)

Second-Fourth Grades \$3,459.00

Fifth-Eighth Grades \$3,535.00

OTHER CHARGES:

Sports fees are paid at the beginning of each sport's season.

Volleyball/Football \$35.00

Basketball \$45.00

Wrestling \$10.00

Graduation Fee (Kindergarten/Eighth Grade) \$10.00

Band Instruments - Information regarding band instrument rental will be made available with varying prices according to the instrument chosen.

Private Music Lessons – Private music teachers should be contacted by parents in regards to their lesson fees.

DISCOUNTS:

Registration Pay by June 1st and receive a 25% discount.

Pay by July 15th and receive a 10% discount.

Comprehensive Fee Pay by July 15th and receive a 10% discount. **All fees must be paid before the start of school.**

Tuition Pay the year's tuition by August 1st and receive a 3% discount. (Grades 2-8)
Pay the semester's tuition by August 1st/January 1st and receive a 1.5% discount. (Grades 2-8)
Members of Calvary Baptist Church in Watertown will receive a 12% discount if the account is current. (Grades 2-8)

DISCOUNTS continued:

Tuition for multiple child (grades 1-8) families

2 children	5%
3 children	15%
4 children	30%
5 children	42%
6 children	50%

POLICY FOR PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS

PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS:

Tuition may be paid in ten monthly payments beginning August 1st, or nine monthly payments beginning September 1st. If the first payment is not received by the middle of August, the account will automatically be placed in the nine month payment schedule (yearly tuition divided by nine). **Comprehensive fees must be paid before the start of school.** All tuition payments are due on the first of each month. If payment is not made by the tenth day of the month, a \$10.00 late fee will be assessed. If payment is not made by the first day of the following month, the child/children may not be allowed to attend school. **If a difficulty arises in making your payment on schedule, please let the administrator know.**

POLICY FOR OLD ACCOUNTS:

Any unpaid balance must be paid before report cards or academic records will be released by CBCS. Any unpaid balance left from a previous year must be paid before the child/children will be allowed to attend school, unless, by written agreement, arrangements are made to include an acceptable percentage of the unpaid balance plus the current tuition in each month's tuition payment.

POLICY FOR GRADUATION:

Graduating students will not be allowed to participate in graduation exercises or receive their diplomas unless their accounts are paid in full before graduation.

POLICY FOR RE-ENROLLMENT:

Students may be enrolled for the 2011/2012 school year even if the account is not paid in full. **If, however, an account is not paid in full by June 1st, the registration fee will be applied to the overdue balance and a place in the class(es) will no longer be held.**

SCHOLARSHIPS:

A limited number of scholarships will be available through the Helping Hands Scholarship Fund. Scholarship funds will be distributed on the basis of need. The number of scholarships given and the dollar amount of each will be determined by the money available, the number of applications received, and the level of need of each applicant. Applications may be obtained from the school office. **The deadline for scholarship applications to be received is June 1, 2011.**
